Watson his heirs and assigns all of that tract of land to wit.

One hundred and ninety acres more or less of Lot Number (189) one hundred and Eight nine in the (5<sup>th</sup>) Fifth District of Irwin County, it being the place where Joshua K. Gray lived and died. To have and to hold the Said described premises with all and Singular the rights members and appurtenances thereunto appertaining to the only proper use benefit and behoof of the Said Mark R. Watson his heirs executors administrators and assigns in fee simple and the Said Frederick Tucker the Said bargained promises unto the Said Mark R. Watson his heirs executors and assigns against the said Frederick Tucker his heirs executors Administrators and against all and every other person Shall and will warrant and forever defend by virtue of these presents.
