On Friday afternoon last Mr. James I. Fountain, on of Montgomery county's oldest citizens died at the residence of his oldest daughter, Mrs. M.J. Thompson, with whom he made his home. The remains were laid to rest in the McGregor cemetery in Mt. Vernon beside those of his wife, who preceded him to the grave by a few years. Rev. J.B. Griner of the Methodist church conducted the funeral services.

Mr. Fountain came to Montgomery county about 30 years ago from Lowndes county. He reached the advanced age of 87 years in January last, and was well known to all our older citizens.

Of his children living there remain four daughters, Mrs. M.J. Thompson, Mrs. Joe Palmer, Mrs. George Jenkins and Mrs. John Hughes; and six sons, William E., J.J., Jessie I., Mitchell N., Milton and David A. Fountain.
