Mrs. Hall was up in age & this was Varn's first year. They were very different & had nothing in common so to speak. They rode to school with W.H. and paid him \$2.50 per month. They were always wanting W.H. to carry them to the show. Neither had a car. Mrs. Hall taught only one year. Varn married Lonnie Hall and continued teaching. When Poplar Springs consolidated with Nashville, she came along with the students. Taught school til she retired. Some of her daughters-in-law still teach.
