Today Keith & I worked in the yards 8-12 a(sic)m. We trimmed, cut, set out azaleas, tilled etc. I was very glad to get it done. We were going to the farm this afternoon. Mary had to go to Macon so Keith had to keep the nursery. I fertilized English peas, turnips, mustard & onions. Planted Oregon English peas on the fence. Also feed and watered my African violets. I have so much needs doing it is hard to tell where to start. Keith partly trimmed the pear on the north side of the backyard. It will be to finish later. I put out azaleas on the north line we had dug up from around some of our plants. Keith tilled by the pear tree on the south side of the yard, by the fence, also fence inside the dog yard. I hope to get that planted next week.
